**FWB and surrounding areas**

We will be attending Detox in the near future. I still need to contact the facility to make arrangements. Wanda will be panel leader and we just have to coordinate to meet with the facility, plan to do that after the holidays. Tentative meeting day will be Tuesday 6:30-7:30pm, more will be revealed.

Thursday (7-8pm) Twelve Oaks – Justin and Nicole have agreed to continue as co panel leaders at Twelve Oaks for the upcoming year. Average attendance is around 35-40 people each week. We have a panel of 2-3 going in every week.

Friday (6:45-7:45 pm) Drug court – Debbie is panel leader. Approximately 15-20 people are currently in the program. We have a panel of 2-3 going in each week.

Mike Barnes is Panel Coordinator for Pensacola and will handle things there, and, of course, if he needs us we are here. We will make arrangements to get literature to him when needed. He has orientated two new H&I members – Diane to go into Keaton and Matt to help support Detox. Welcome new members!

**PENSACOLA and surrounding areas**

H&I meetings are still being held at the same locations as listed in previous H&I reports. Kyle M. & Ed are the panel leaders, with LJ attending regularly at Detox/DAART on Tuesday and Thursday nights (7:00-8:00 pm).

Escambia County Men's Jail – Thursday (6:30-7:30pm). Mike B is presently facilitating the meeting. At this present time we need more willingness to help facilitate this meeting as well as panel members.

Men's PFC is held every Friday at 5:45 P.M. at the Fairfield Work Release. Paul is panel leader. Attendance is about 20-25 men ranging in age from 19-50. These men are phased up and are attending our regular NA meetings.

Saturday (6:30-7:30 pm) Keaton meetings need male and female help. Keirsten is the panel leader. Average attendance is about 40 people.

Women's Jail – Tentative start date 01/05/09 (Monday). Weekly meeting from 6-7pm. Stephanie F. is panel leader. She is waiting for background check forms to be approved. She has willing panel members for this meeting, YEAH!

We also have other incarceration facilities that are begging for NA to come in but we don't have the willingness. If you are interested, talk with your sponsor and Mike Barnes or myself and get involved. We are looking for a 6 month commitment so that you can give back what was freely given to you.
