1. **PI SOLICITING FOR NEW SUBCOMMITTEE CHAIR:** Our Area is continuing to look for a new PI Subcommittee Chairperson. I will do whatever it takes to train the incoming PI Chair so that our Area is not left hanging. The GPANA PI Subcommittee Chair has the following duties and responsibilities:

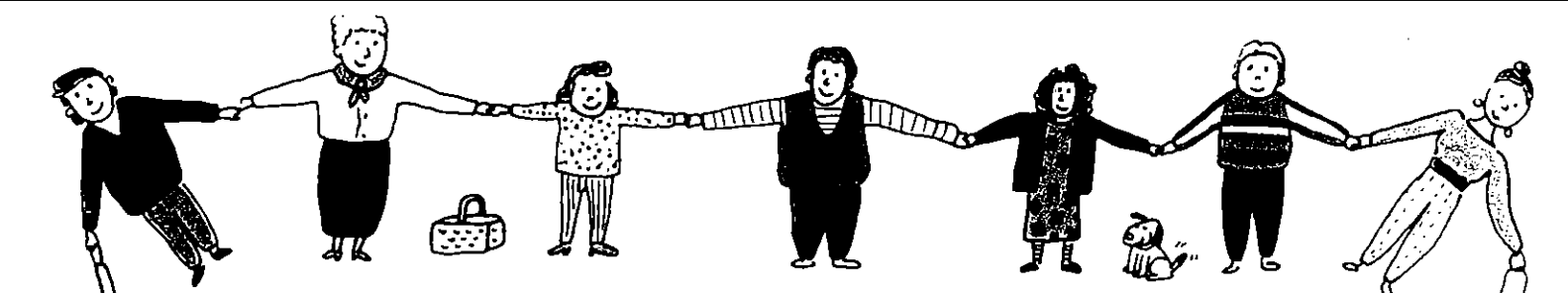

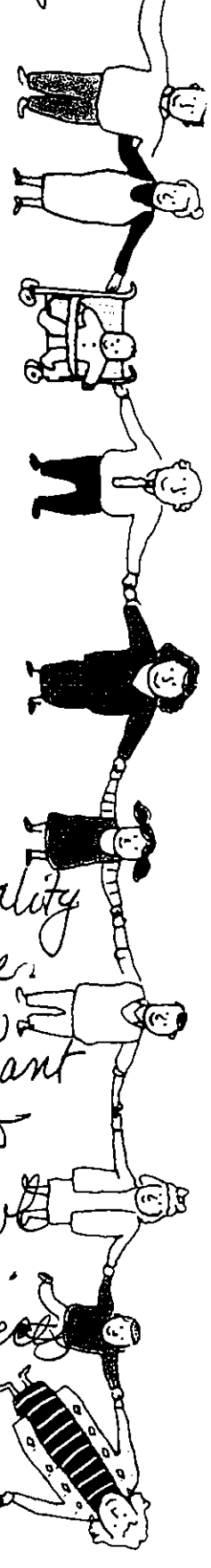
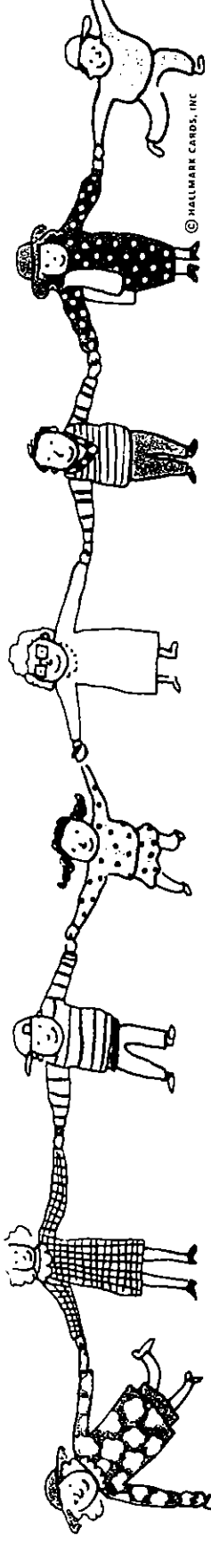

Dear ASC,


I would like to take this opportunity to express my thanks and gratitude for the opportunity to serve Narcotics Anonymous and the Greater Pensacola Area on this committee.

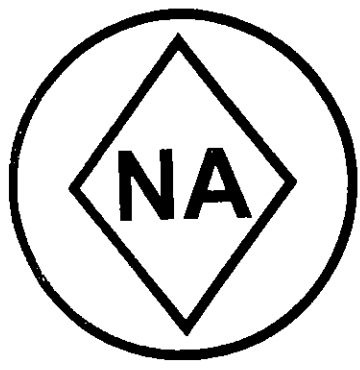
